The Tanana Valley Railroad Museum, located in Pioneer Park, Alaska, and operated by FTVRR, Inc., is a living museum. It is dedicated to the purpose of educating and informing the public about the Tanana Valley Railroad's role, history and influence on Interior Alaska.

The museum will use historic objects, interactive displays, static displays, and an operating narrow gauge passenger railroad. The time period of interest for the displays and exhibits will be limited to the years between 1897 to the present, with a special emphasis on the 1897 to 1930 period.
